Pupil Questionnaire

In November the governors asked the children to complete a questionnaire about the school. Some of the findings –

- 100 % of pupils agree that the staff helps them to do their best.*
- 96% of pupils agree that they enjoy school.*
- 99% of pupils agree that their teachers give them work that challenges them.*
- 98% of pupils agree that they enjoy learning at this school.*
- 1000% of pupils agree that there is an adult at school that they can talk to if something is worrying them.*
- 98% of pupils agree that the behaviour of other children around school is good.*
- 100% of pupils agree that the school encourages them to look after their emotional and mental health.*
- 100% of pupils agree that the school encourages them to respect people from other backgrounds and to treat everyone equally.*
- 99% of pupils agree that they feel safe when they are at school.*
