Questions or queries about Maths or Science or anything about Kingfishers.



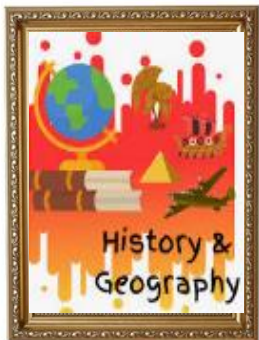
Mr Judge

School Council

Your Class Councillors



School Council Meetings take place usually each month - tell your class councillors if you'd like something to change.

What shall I do?...

Tell the adult who is in charge of the subject.

Tell any member of the School Council.

Write the concern or complaint into the 'Chameleon Complaint Box'.

Complaint or concern gets taken to the school council which may be taken to the Senior Leadership Team in school.

Decision or solution based on

- Money
- Resources (staff, time)

Decision will be taken back to either the individual or class who may decide to talk to the Headteacher about their idea/complaint.
