Poor Behaviour Choices Inside and outside school

Behaviour Tree Sanctions

One warning/Reminder

Move to yellow
(from perfect day or above)

Move to orange

Restorative Practice at the next breaktime (reflection)
Wrens – Thinking Chair (Autumn & Spring)

Move to red

As the orange sanction and parents informed by the S.L.T.

Buddy Class

Continued poor behaviour
(Wrens & Kingfishers, Robins & Kestrels, Eagles & Office)

In School Suspension/Out of School Suspension

9 reds or extreme behaviour
Work given outside the office or at home
